- *Helianthus* (sunflower)
- *Rudbeckia* (black-eyed susan)
- *Echinacea* (coneflower)
- *Phlox nivalis* (trailing phlox)
- *Monarda* (bee balm)
- *Verbena canadensis*
- *Verbena hastata*
- *Salvia* (sage)
- *Sedum*
- *Muhlenbergia* (muhly grass)
