## 2010-11 AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM

The mission of the CPSC After School Program is to support the social, emotional, intellectual and physical development of students through age-appropriate enrichment and recreational activities during after school hours.

Kindergarten through 5<sup>th</sup> grade will be divided into 3 groups based on their ages/grade levels.

The daily schedule is as follows:

3:05PM	check-in/attendance and outside time
3:40PM	snack and meeting time
4:00PM	quiet reading/homework time
4:30PM	activity time
5:45 - 6:00PM	pick-up in the lobby

Between 4:00pm and pick-up time, students will often be involved in the following activities:

### **Exploratoriums:**

Guest artists are brought in during ASP to facilitate hour-long classes over a period of time. These classes are generally arts based and are offered free of charge to students enrolled in the After School Program. This past year our students enjoyed Djembe Drumming with Shannon Morrow and Creative Dance with Gaspard Louis – formerly of Pilobolus Dance Theater.

### **After School Clubs!:**

ASC's are a new edition this year. A club may be lessons in music, foreign language and drama or extra support (tutoring) in any of the core subjects. They will be offered each quarter and are open to all CPSC students.

There is a one-time enrollment fee of \$20.00 due at registration and full payment is due one week prior to start date of club. These clubs will provide families the convenience of extracurricular activities at CPSC after 3:15pm.

They are similar to an Exploratorium but not exclusive to ASP. Information on 1<sup>st</sup> quarter clubs will be available on the first day of school. Future club information can be found in the Parent Updates.
