

## **2011 PROOF OF RESIDENCY NEEDED FROM ALL CPSC FAMILIES**

The State of North Carolina requires that we have documentation to show proof of residency for all children attending our school. This information is used to verify the county you reside in, which is used to determine how much funding we receive from each county and the state. Without verification, we may not receive funds for your child. Our state and local county funds are the main source of revenue for Charter Schools. Please submit one of the following forms of residency verification before August 2, 2011.

We need residency verification every year. (The state does not assume that you did not move since the last school year, so we need proof in our files.) If you are a new family to CPSC and have provided this information when you registered since April, you do not need to send additional proof of residency.

Please give this information to the teacher during the home visit if you are able to. If you are concerned about confidentiality, please put it in a sealed envelope labeled "Proof of Residency."

1. We need a utility statement (gas, electric, water), lease agreement, mortgage statement, or a deed for a home. These are the same documents that other school districts require as well.
2. If you choose to use a utility bill, we need a copy of a document from you. We cannot access your utility accounts on line.
